Like most websites, we use cookies to help provide the best possible experience to all our visitors. The information below explains what cookies are and how our website uses them.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your device when you visit a website. Cookies are then sent back to the originating website on each subsequent visit, or to another website that recognises that cookie. Cookies do lots of different jobs, like letting you navigate between pages efficiently, remembering your preferences, and generally improve the user experience. They can also help to ensure that adverts you see online are more relevant to you and your interests. The cookies used on this website have been categorised based on the categories found in the International Chamber of Commerce UK Cookie guide. A list of all the cookies used on this website by category is set out below.

CATEGORY 1: STRICTLY NECESSARY COOKIES

These cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around the website and use its features, such as accessing secure areas of the website. Without these cookies services you have asked for, like shopping baskets or e-billing, cannot be provided.

allow_cookies - Lets us know that you have consented to allow our website to use cookies.

sessionid - A random value that lets our website remember who you are when you register or login.

csrftoken - Helps us protect you against cross site request forgery.

region - Lets us know which country you are from, so that we can show you the right products.

Category 2: performance cookies

These cookies collect information about how visitors use a website, for instance which pages visitors go to most often, and if they get error messages from web pages. These cookies don't collect information that identifies a visitor. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. It is only used to improve how a website works.

__utma, __utmb, __utmc, __utmz, __utmv, __utmz - These six cookies are used by a third-party service called Google Analytics, which we use to help understand how people find and use our

site. Google has some [comprehensive information](#) on how they use cookies, from where you can also view their privacy policy.
